CHICAGO, IL (MAY 2008) – Jennifer Murphy, Chicago author of *The Green Eaters – A Dream Comes True*, is teaming up with Greg Christian, founder of Organic School Project (OSP), to stress the importance of green living, positive food, and respect for all living things at Chicago Green Festival, May 17-18 on Navy Pier, booth 2215. OSP, which has a licensing agreement to utilize the characters in *The Green Eaters* in its evolving curriculum, will receive 50% of all *The Green Eaters* merchandise sales during Green Festival.

The Green Eaters – A Dream Comes True was created specifically for young children to understand from an early age the importance of organic living and humane treatment of animals and our earth. In the story, a cow, sheep, horse, pig and chicken comprise *The Green Eaters* characters, each teaching a special aspect of animals living naturally on a farm.

OSP, the not for profit program within Chicago Public Schools that works to provide youth with a mindful foundation for a healthy and sustainable lifestyle through school-based wellness programming initiatives will be using *The Green Eaters* characters within their curriculum, as the characters allow students to visualize where their food comes from in accordance to their lesson plans.

“I created this book to introduce kids to more than what noises the animals make or what they eat,” says Murphy. *The Green Eaters* offers a lighthearted way to introduce the concept of the life of animals on a factory farm versus life on an organic farm. I’m excited that the characters will be brought to life in OSP’s curriculum and allow the children to really learn about our ties to animals and the importance of treating them humanely as nature intended. By helping to fund OSP, I’m giving to a cause I believe greatly in, as it’s important to teach our children at a young age about the natural cycle of life.”

Additionally, Murphy’s organic baby and toddler clothing line, Chapter One Organics, will be on display at Chicago Green Festival for attendees to touch, feel and buy!

She researched and found a problem with harmful pesticides in cotton crops and the effects of those pesticides on society as a whole. In turn, she learned more about organic farming and the devastation factory farming brought to our ecosystem. After noticing there were not many books addressing these issues for children, she started writing based on her own childhood surrounded by family farms, as well as, a family trip she had taken with her husband and children. The animals she created for her book were happy, natural and free, the way nature intended. “The Green Eaters” promotes this message as well as an awareness for children to understand the value of positive choices from farm to plate.

The Green Eaters – A Dream Comes True book prints on recycled paper at an operation in Canada that uses both wind and solar power. *The Green Eaters* book retails for \$12.99 and the organic cotton character bibs for \$12.50.
